*** Minimum Release Requirements:**

As a Driver

- Satisfactory completion of all orientation activities – as evidenced by completed check sheets.
- Satisfactory completion of an EVOC 2 (or EVOC 3) course.
- Satisfactory completion of CPR course.
- Satisfactory completion of a minimum of three (3) “Training Runs” to Augusta Health, UVA, Martha Jefferson or Lynchburg General
- Three (3) “Observer” runs in the back of an ambulance.
- Two emergent runs to the scene with your mentor

As an EMT

- Satisfactory completion of training specified by the State of Virginia.
- Training on Wintergreen Rescue Squad radio procedures, Standard Operating Guidelines (SOG’s), location of equipment on ambulances, Ski Patrol procedures, and other subjects as directed by the Training Captain.

The volunteer member shall notify the Training Captain when they have completed all requirements and feel he/she is ready to “be released.” Each volunteer must complete an assessment with the Training Captain.
